L'ANTI-BARBOUZE


UN DOCUMENT IMPITOYABLE

Le 18 octobre 1963, Philippe Thyraud de Vosjoli, depuis 1951 représentant du SDECE à Washington, envoyait sa lettre de démission au général de Gaulle.

Convaincu de l'infiltration soviétique au sein des services de renseignements français et du Cabinet français, désavoué par son propre gouvernement et par une certaine presse, de Vosjoli n'avait pas d'autre choix que d'agir en solitaire.

LAMIA, nom de code de Thyraud de Vosjoli, est le récit sans fard d'un agent secret qui a servi son pays pendant vingt ans, de la Résistance jusqu'à la V^e République. Bien plus que des souvenirs, Lamia est la dénonciation de l'intrigue, de la corruption, de l'assassinat politique, l'histoire d'un engrenage que Léon Uris allait romancer dans «Topaz», le témoignage direct et sans équivoque d'un homme meurtri qui s'est toujours refusé à devenir un barbouze.

CORRESPONDANCE INÉDITE DU GÉNÉRAL DE GAULLE



A 20 ans, de Vosjoli, s'engage dans la Résistance. En 1942, il s'évade vers le Maroc, par l'Espagne où il est emprisonné pendant 9 mois. Fin 1943, il dirige la section Extrême-Orient des Services de Renseignements du Gouvernement d'Alger; après une mission en Chine, il devient responsable de la section Angleterre à la Direction générale des Etudes et Recherches qui se transforme en SDECE (Service de Documentation Extérieure et de

Chef de Cabinet du SDECE, de Vosjoli sera, par la suite, représentant de la Direction générale du SDECE à Washington, de 1951 à 1963 et, à ce titre, chargé de la liaison avec l'OTAN et la CIA. Depuis sa démission, de Vosjoli est resté aux Etats-Unis, exerçant des activités d'écrivain et de journaliste; il est actuellement considéré comme l'un des meilleurs experts de la question du trafic de la drogue.

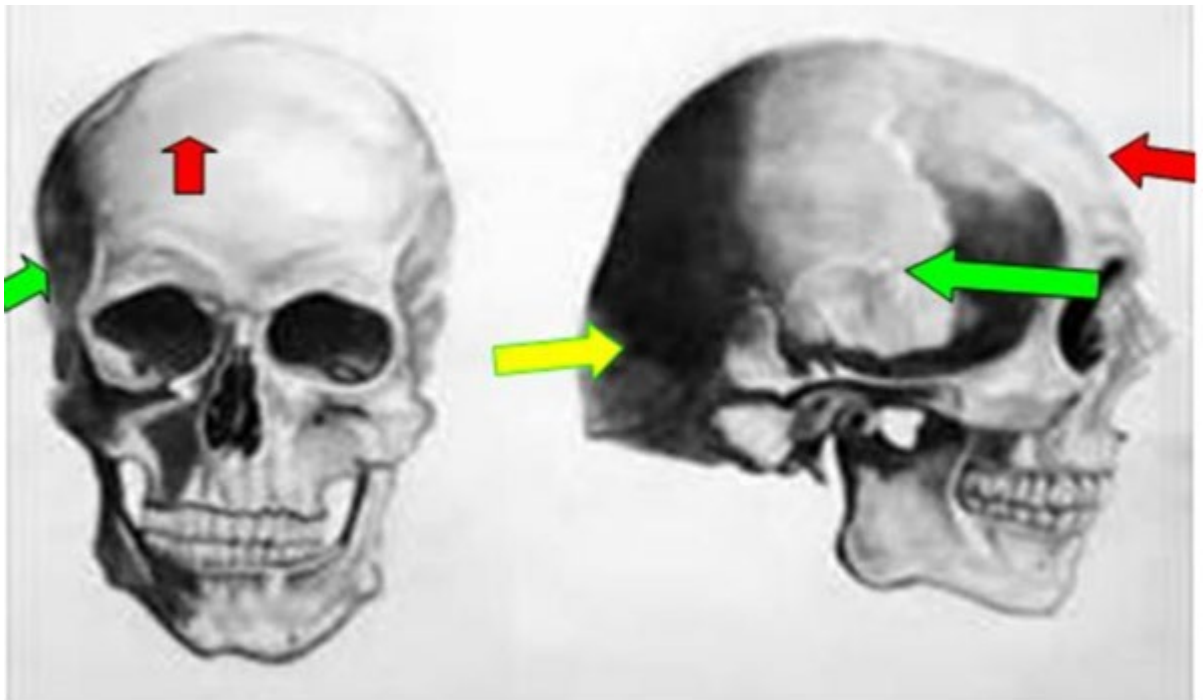
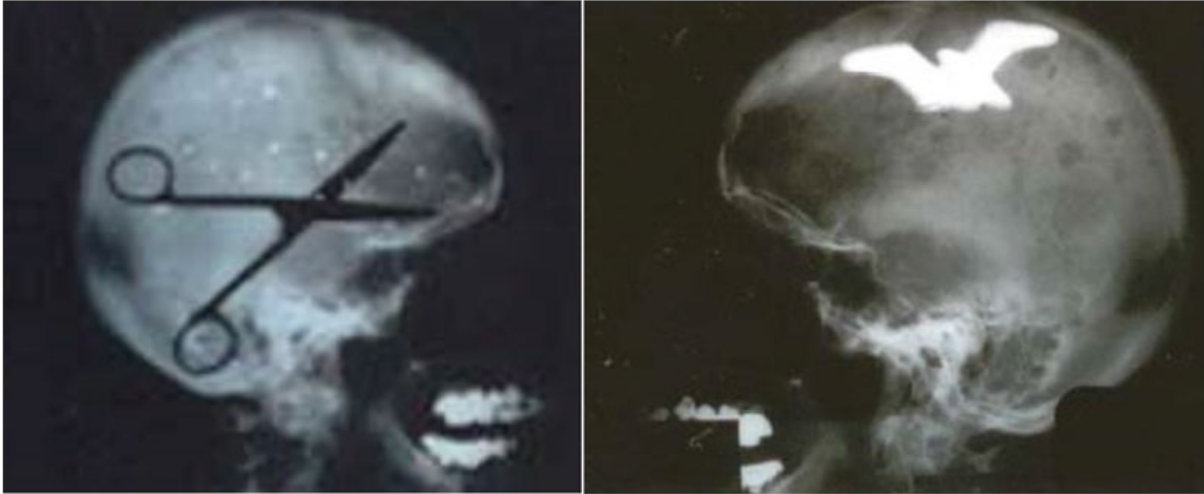


Rydberg Drawing vs. JFK's Shirt

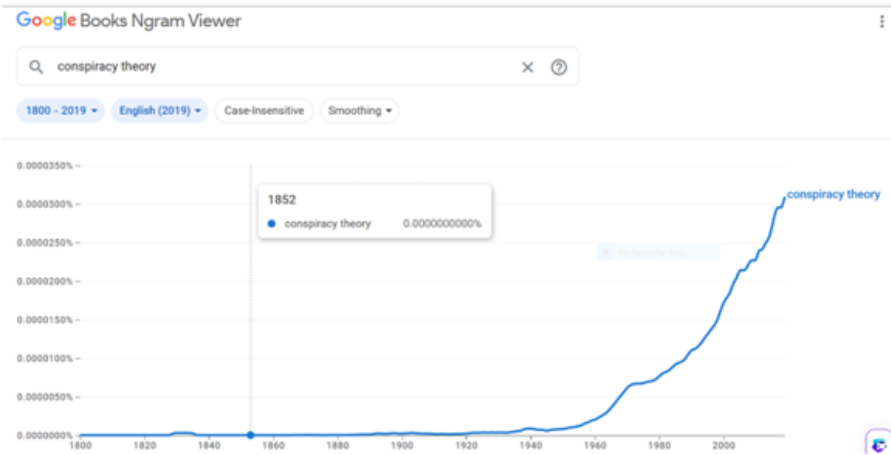

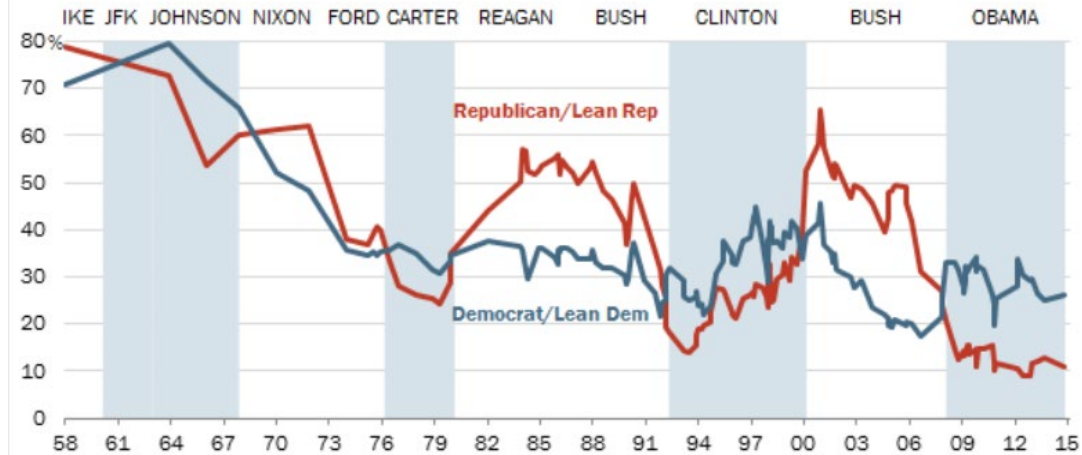

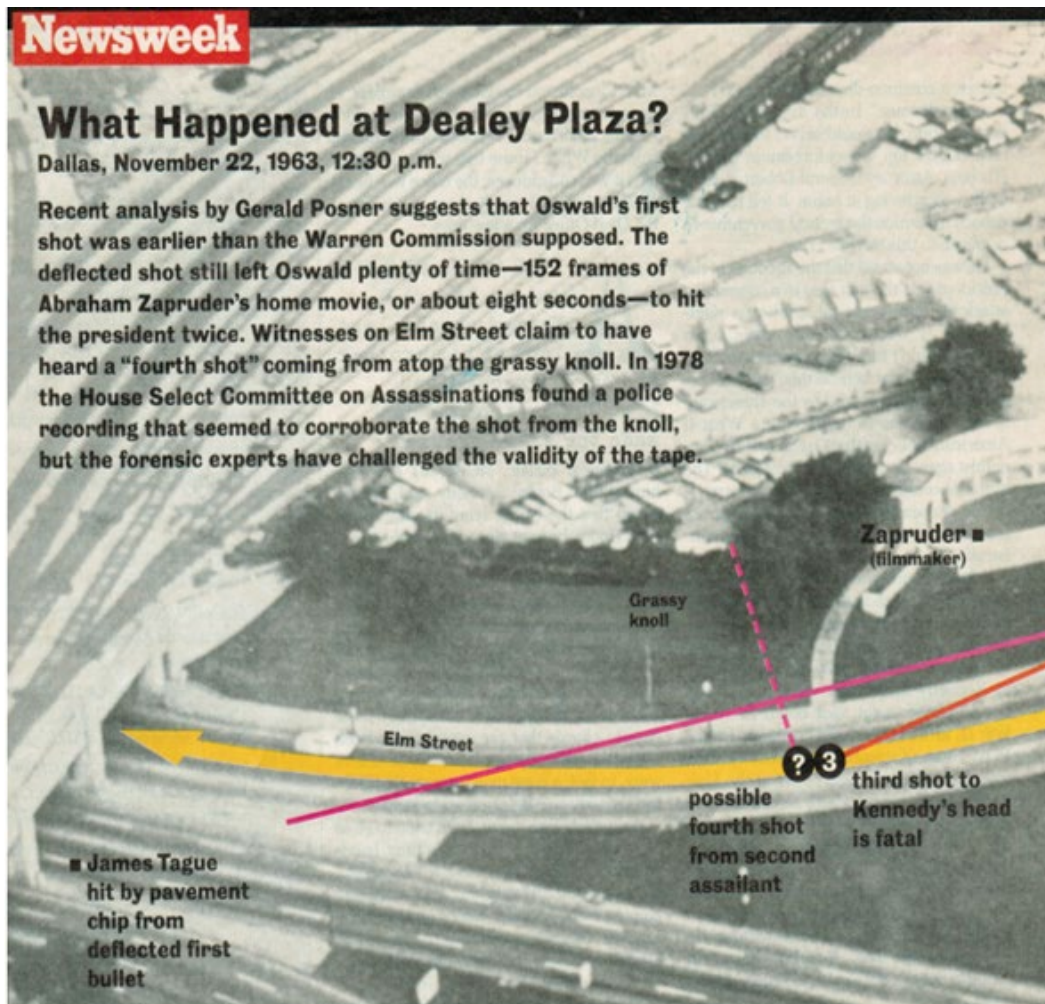
Trust in government by party: 1958-2015
